

SENIOR ACADEMIC POSITION IN CHAIR OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE, ESTONIAN UNIVERSITY OF LIFE SCIENCES

The chair in landscape architecture has a vacancy for a **full-time senior lecturer of landscape architecture** (with a possibility of part-time if this is more convenient), starting from **1. January 2023**, with a **focus** on the direction, management and development of the bachelor programme as well as wider strategic development of the Chair and involvement in research (including working on applications and seeking funding).

Applicants should be a landscape architect with a PhD and either be primarily Estonian speaking with a good command of English or with international credentials and willing to learn Estonian within a year. **Preference** will be given to applicants with qualifications and/or significant experience of teaching at university level and ideally with experience of research.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach on several courses as part of a teaching team, contribute to research work and to supervise several bachelor and master theses, although the primary role is developmental and supportive to the chair professor, Dr Simon Bell.

The post will be based in the chair of landscape architecture at **Kreutzwaldi 56/3, Tartu, Estonia**. After one year the successful candidate will be evaluated with the possibility to move to the tenure track towards a professorship.

Salary will be in line with the university average for the grade but is negotiable according to qualifications and experience. The university offers good holidays and a range of other benefits.

The chair is the only full size university department of landscape architecture in Estonia. There are three study programmes: bachelor in environmental planning and landscape design and two master programmes, one in English (an international programme attracting students from a wide range of countries) and one in Estonian. The chair also receives many Erasmus exchange students and the teaching staff is also international, leading to a very diverse community. The chair has been involved in many international research and development projects with Estonian and EU funding. There is cooperation with other similar departments within the Baltic Sea region and more widely. The chair professor, Dr Simon Bell has a high international profile and served two terms as president of ECLAS (European Council of Landscape Architecture Schools).
